

Immigration document checks: I am studying at Cambridge for less than 6 months as a visitor



Did you apply for a visitor visa before coming to the UK?

Yes, I obtained a visitor visa prior to coming to the UK

I applied for my visa in advance of coming to the UK and received a visitor vignette (sticker) in my passport
This applies to those who attended a Visa Application Centre

DOCUMENTS TO PROVIDE

- 1) Passport
- 2) Visitor vignette (visa) with entry stamp

No, I did not apply for a visitor visa prior to coming to the UK

I requested entry at the UK border and received a date stamp in my passport

This applies to non-visa nationals who saw a Border Force Officer when they passed through immigration control

DOCUMENTS TO PROVIDE

- 1) Passport
- 2) Entry stamp

I entered the UK via the eGates and do not have an entry stamp in my passport

This only applies to nationals of Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand, Singapore, South Korea, the US, Switzerland or a country in the EEA

DOCUMENTS TO PROVIDE

- 1) Passport
- 2) Evidence of date of entry to the UK*.

***Evidence of date of entry to the UK**

Acceptable evidence would be your flight ticket, email confirmation of your flight itinerary, or your boarding pass. This can be provided as a paper document or by showing the evidence on your phone or other device. This evidence is required as the University must have a record of the date that you entered the UK.

This only applies if you are a national of Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand, Singapore, South Korea, the US, Switzerland or a country in the EEA and you entered the UK via the eGates i.e. you did not get a date stamp in your passport.
